



Research Fellowship in Geriatric Pharmacotherapy

The University of Pittsburgh Schools of Medicine and Pharmacy are offering a 2 year research fellowship in geriatric pharmacotherapy.

Goals of the Research Fellowship

- 1) Provide intensive mentored research experience by established faculty in preparation for an independent research career in geriatric drug therapy research.
- 2) Provide opportunities for academic teaching experience.
- 3) Develop and perfect academic skills.

Research Support

T32 grant from the National Institute on Aging and several extramural government grants including R01's, K07 and a Claude Pepper Center. A competitive stipend with benefits and travel support is provided.

Applicant Requirements

Applicants should possess a PharmD degree and should preferably have prior residency experience relevant to geriatrics. Research emphasis areas include, but are not limited to, pharmacoepidemiology and pharmaceutical outcomes research.

Application Process

By January 12, 2010 interested individuals should send:

- 1) A cover letter indicating what areas of research they would be interested in pursuing through a geriatrics fellowship
- 2) A curriculum vitae with names and contact information for references
- 3) Three letters of support
- 4) Transcripts from your pharmacy school curriculum
