



## **Clinician in Geriatrics Needed to Staff PACE Program**

Full-time Geriatrician is sought for Community LIFE, a Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) affiliated with the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center, in the Pittsburgh region. The Geriatrician is responsible for managing the medical care of the PACE program participants across the health care continuum and is an integral member of an Interdisciplinary Team, which continually assesses each patient, develops and provides a comprehensive (social, medical, spiritual) plan of care. The position requires an individual with a demonstrable grasp of chronic illness management and palliative medicine. The qualified physician shall have the leadership skills to lead the team and explain medical decision-making to the team, the participant and their caregivers.

The clinician will join colleagues in the Division of Geriatric Medicine at the University of Pittsburgh who have a passion for patient care, quality improvement and scholarly activity. Ample educational opportunities are available as well, since the division provides geriatric education to trainees at all levels, including teaching in all four years of the medical school, required rotations for residents in internal medicine and other disciplines, and a fellowship program in geriatric medicine. The University is ranked among the nation's top 10 in NIH funding, while its health system is ranked in the nation's topmost clinical tier by *US News and World Report* and the Division is ranked 8<sup>th</sup> in Geriatrics. In addition, within the last year Pittsburgh has been named Best Arts City, Most Livable City, and Best Urban Adventure City and remains one of America's most affordable and best places to live.

### **Minimum Requirements:**

- MD Degree from an accredited university.
- Pennsylvania Licensure and DEA registration.
- Board Certified in Internal or Family Medicine.
- Certificate of added qualification in Geriatric Medicine or extensive experience in the care of a chronically ill, frail, elderly population.
- Minimum of one year of experience with a frail, elderly population, 2-3 years experience in working with interdisciplinary team and/or in managed care settings preferred.
